

# The Missing Transition Zone

The path out of high-strain work can determine whether strain releases or carries forward.

## Scenario Context

A high-cognition team exits a technical, sterile, machine-dominant, screen-heavy, or operationally precise work zone directly into a hallway, open office, meeting area, or general circulation path. There is no environmental threshold that helps the body and attention system shift states.

## Paikoro Read

Paikoro would read this as a compression-threshold failure. The organization may be focused on the technical room or the break area, but the highest-leverage opportunity may be the immediate exit path between strain and recovery.

## Risk Pattern Table

Observed Condition	Risk Pattern	Operational Meaning
Direct exit from technical strain zone to general circulation	Strain carryover	Workers leave the room physically, but not cognitively.
No lighting shift or sensory cue	State-change failure	The environment gives no signal that demand has changed.
No natural anchor at the threshold	Recovery delay	Restoration begins late or not at all.
No brief landing point	Abrupt re-entry	Employees move from strain into interruption without decompression.
Recovery space exists too far downstream	Delayed relief	The system asks people to carry strain before reaching support.

## Environmental Systems Opportunity

The opportunity is to design a Biophilic Recovery Threshold: a transition layer immediately outside the technical strain zone that interrupts carryover. This can include plants or botanical visual anchors, warmer lighting, acoustic softening, tactile material shifts, air-quality cues, brief seating, and a deliberate route toward deeper restoration or productive re-entry.

## Paikoro Principle

### Principle

Recovery begins at the threshold, not after the damage has already traveled through the building.
